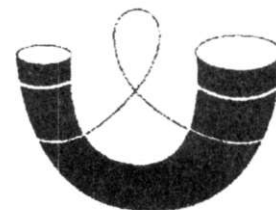

Before being given a tour of the building, members will hear a talk on the history of the Hall and its work, and on the collection of the time-pieces on display (together with details of resident ghosts, supposedly experienced in the Hall!)

There is a small coffee shop adjacent to the Hall where morning coffee and light lunches are available. There is also a public house over the road, and, of course, Southwell and Newark are quite close and plenty of eating places can be found there.
